

## The Pacesetter Way

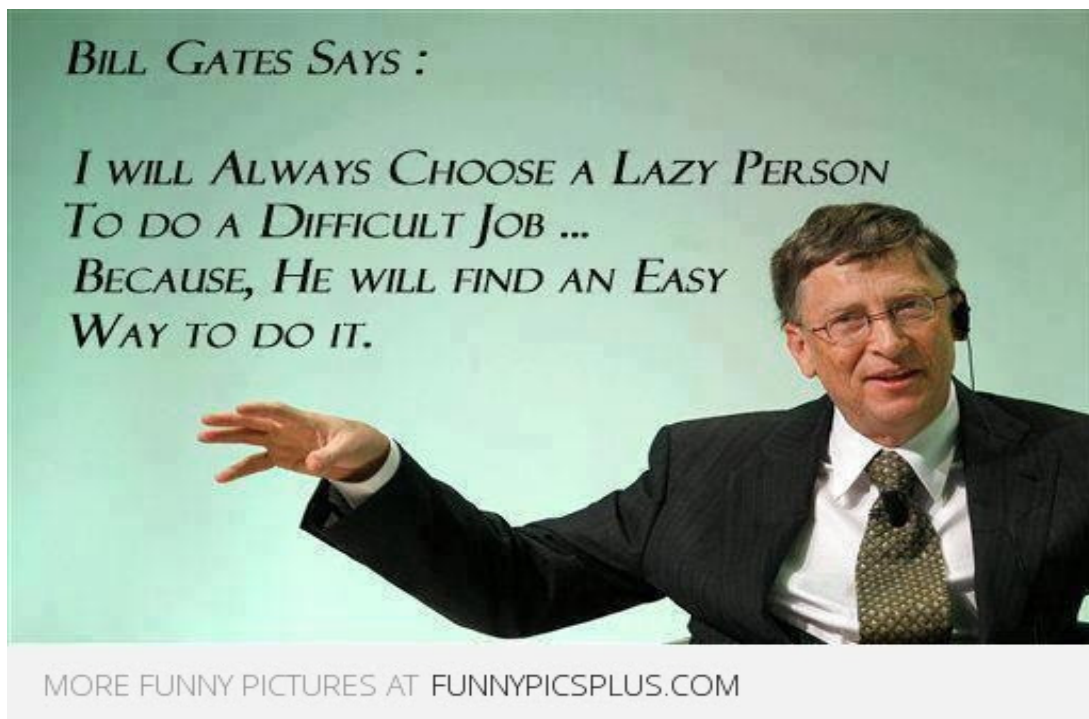
It is everyone's individual responsibility to appropriately encourage and help all associates consistently follow these behaviors.

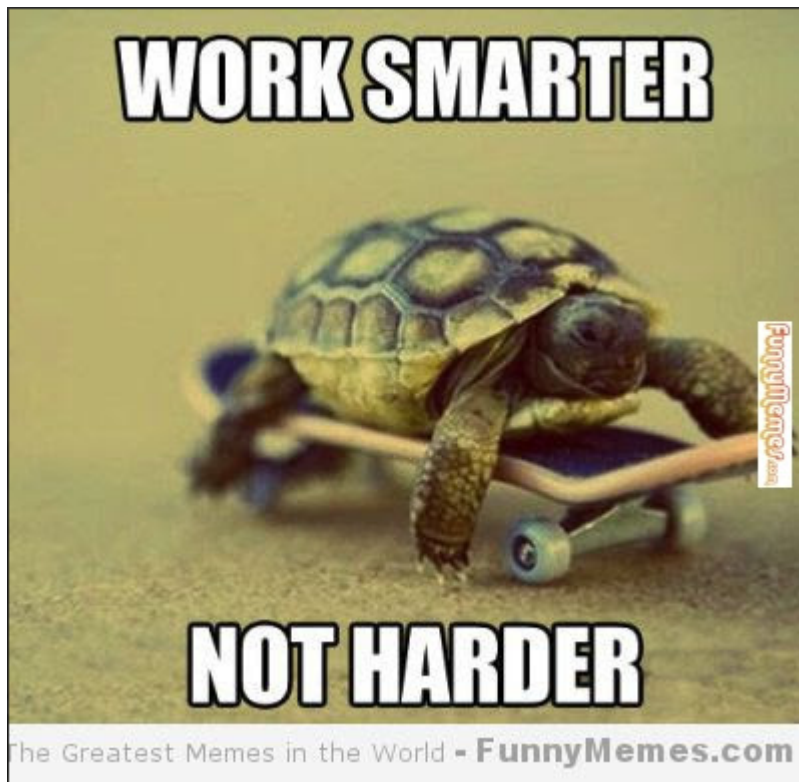
**9. Keep it Fun: Keep everything in perspective. Be lighthearted. Smile!
